Teledesic LLC is currently licensed to provide fixed-satellite service in the 28.6-29.1 GHz and 18.8-19.3 GHz bands, using a constellation of non-geostationary satellites. On February 1, 2002, Teledesic sought the Commission's permission to modify its licensed constellation; that application remains pending as File No. SAT-MOD-20020201-00011.

Teledesic hereby surrenders the license referenced above and asks that the related modification application be dismissed. Teledesic also has no objection to the suppression of all ITU filings for LEOSAT-1.
