SES AMERICOM, Inc. ("SES AMERICOM"), by its attorneys, hereby withdraws the above-referenced applications. The applications relate to a proposed redeployment of SES AMERICOM's current and planned satellites. Specifically, SES AMERICOM had proposed to operate its planned AMC-9 satellite at the 72° W.L. orbital location (File No. SAT-AMD-20021015-00188), to relocate AMC-6 from 72° W.L. to 101° W.L. (File Nos. SAT-MOD-20021127-00232 and SAT-AMD-20030131-00007) and to relocate AMC-4 from 101° W.L. to 85° W.L. (File No. SAT-MOD-20030314-00028). However, SES AMERICOM's business requirements have changed, and SES AMERICOM no longer plans to implement these alterations in its fleet.
