## Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's rules<sup>1</sup> and the Supplemental Order issued in MB Docket No. 03-124 on April 9, 2004,<sup>2</sup> DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC ("DIRECTV Enterprises") hereby requests that its pending application for minor modification of its DBS system and for authorization to relocate and operate its DIRECTV 6 satellite, File No. SAT-MOD-20030613-00121, be amended to reflect the *de facto* transfer of control of The DIRECTV Group, Inc. ("DIRECTV Group") (formerly, Hughes Electronics Corporation<sup>3</sup>) from General Motors Corporation to The News Corporation Limited ("News Corp.").<sup>4</sup>
