Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Mobile Satellite Users Association (MSUA) submits this letter in the above proceedings in which MSUA raised concerns about the potential for interference into the MSS from the implementation of ATC in the MSS bands. We understand that Mobile Satellite Ventures LP, Mobile Satellite Ventures (Canada) Inc., and Inmarsat Global Limited recently entered into a long-term coordination agreement regarding the operation of Inmarsat's and MSV's communications systems in North America, and that, pursuant to that agreement, and subject to it being accepted by the relevant Administrations (United States, Canada, and the United Kingdom), Inmarsat has withdrawn its Application for Review and other filings in the above proceedings. For these reasons, and based on the assurances of Inmarsat and MSV (as corporate members of MSUA) that our concerns are being addressed with the FCC, MSUA withdraws its filing dated January 11, 2005 with respect to the above proceedings.

For the avoidance of doubt, MSUA is not withdrawing its filing dated January 11, 2005 with respect to the ATC Rulemaking, IB Docket No. 01-185.
