This morning I spoke with Alyssa Roberts of the FCC's International Bureau concerning Celsat's response to a letter from Fern Jarmulnek to the undersigned dated March 9, 2005. The March 9 letter requests certain additional information in connection with Celsat's modification application, File No. SAT-MOD-20040717-00134, and requests that the information be filed with the FCC no later than March 23, 2005.
