Intelsat LLC's (Intelsat) request, File Nos. SAT-MOD-20040730-00152 and SAT-AMD-20040903-00165, to operate its C/Ku band satellite, INTELSAT 706, at the 50.25° E.L. orbital location IS GRANTED.¹ Accordingly, Intelsat is authorized to operate INTELSAT 706 in the 3700-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth), 5925-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space), 10.95-11.25 GHz (space-to-Earth), 11.45-11.70 GHz (space-to-Earth), 11.70-11.95 GHz (space-to-Earth), 12.5-12.75 GHz (space-to-Earth), and 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands at the 50.25° E.L. orbital location in accordance with the terms, conditions, and technical specifications set forth in its applications, this Attachment and the Federal Communications Commission's (Commission) Rules.²

1. Intelsat's operations shall be on a non-harmful interference basis, *i.e.*, Intelsat shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating satellites.
2. In the event that any harmful interference does occur, Intelsat shall cease operations immediately and shall inform the FCC in writing immediately of such an event.
3. Intelsat shall maintain full operational control of the INTELSAT 706 satellite at all times.
4. Intelsat shall inform its customers that operations at the 54.85 E.L. orbital location are on a non-harmful interference basis and that Intelsat must cease operations upon notification to the United States Administration of such interference; and
5. This authorization is issued on the understanding that to the extent Intelsat, pursuant to its agreements with Shin Satellite (Shinsat) and Turksat Uydu Haberlesme ve Isletme A.S. (Turksat AS), both private companies, will conform

its operations to parameters agreed to in coordination agreements between the Administration of Thailand, the Turkish Administration and other Administrations, responsibility for both compliance with and enforcing compliance with those agreements is a matter which would arise under private law.

6. This authorization is also issued on the understanding that, in regards to filings with the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), the Administration of Thailand and the Turkish Administration are not acting pursuant to Article 9.1 of the Radio Regulation, on behalf of the United States Administration.
7. This authorization is also issued on the understanding that the Federal Communications Commission remains the licensing administration, for purposes of ITU Radio Regulation 18.1, for the INTELSAT 706 satellite, and that the operations of the INTELSAT 706 satellite are pursuant to ITU Radio Regulation 4.4.
8. Intelsat shall prepare and submit to the Federal Communications Commission, within fifteen days following grant of this authorization, the necessary materials for submission to the ITU, pursuant to Article 8.4 of the Radio Regulations, in connection with the operations of the INTELSAT 706 satellite at the 50.25° E.L. orbital location.
9. Intelsat shall reduce its earth station input power density relative to INTELSAT 602's former operations at 50.5° E.L. orbital location in conformance with item 9 of its amended application explaining Intelsat's proposed operation of INTELSAT 706 at 50.25° E.L.³
10. This authorization is issued on the understanding that this grant is not an approval of any specific agreement entered into by Intelsat, its subsidiaries, and affiliates, nor of any specific provision of any such agreement, concerning operation of the Intelsat 706 satellite, nor is it an approval of an agreement concerning any related matter, nor of any specific provision of any such agreement concerning any related matter.
11. This authorization is issued on the understanding that this grant, and any previous grants at the 50.25° E.L. orbital location, do not in any way express a view concerning, or agreement as to, the validity or lack of validity of any ITU filing at or within the vicinity of the 50.25° E.L. orbital location.
12. In connection with the provision of service in any particular country, Intelsat is obliged to comply with the applicable laws, regulations, rules, and licensing procedures of that country.

13. Intelsat is afforded thirty days from the date of release of this action to decline this grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned.
14. This Grant is used pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective upon release. Petitions for reconsideration under Section 1.106 or applications for review under Section 1.115 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§1.106, 1.115, may be filed within 30 days of the date of the public notice indicating that this action was taken.
