Intelsat North America LLC ("Intelsat") hereby notifies the Commission that it has successfully de-orbited its Marisat F2 satellite. The de-orbiting was completed on October 31, 2008. The final predicted orbit perigee of the Marisat F2 satellite is 349 km above the geostationary arc; the apogee is 1257 km above the arc. In the course of de-orbiting the satellite, Intelsat depleted the propellant tanks, discharged the batteries, disconnected the power from the bus, and shut off the transmitters.
