Dear Ms. Dortch:

In response to an inquiry from staff in the Commission's International Bureau, Globalstar LLC (formerly known as New Operating Globalstar LLC) and Globalstar USA LLC (collectively "Globalstar") are filing this letter for association with the above-referenced applications to confirm that there has been no change in the ownership or control of Globalstar since the Commission consented to the assignment and transfer of control of the licenses and authorizations held by Globalstar, L.P., and certain of its subsidiaries (the "Globalstar Authorizations") to Globalstar LLC that would require any prior approval of, or other filing with, the Commission.<sup>1/</sup>

As contemplated in Globalstar's application seeking approval of,<sup>2/</sup> and as authorized in the International Bureau's Public Notice approving,<sup>3/</sup> the assignment and transfer of control of



the Globalstar Authorizations, Globalstar L.P.'s former creditors, who became the minority owners of Globalstar LLC, now have acquired an additional 17.62 percent interest in Globalstar LLC, so that their current total holdings equal about 36 percent.
