
Re: Application to Modify License for INTELSAT 602 (S2389)

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat LLC ("Intelsat") recently filed the above-referenced application to modify the license for INTELSAT 602 to allow its operation at the 150.5° E.L. orbital location. In Exhibit B to that application, Intelsat supplied a May 9, 2005 letter from Indosat, in which Indosat stated, among other things, that Indonesia has licensed Indosat to operate a satellite at 150.5° E.L. and that the operation of INTELSAT 602 at 150.5° E.L. is governed by a license provided by the FCC, and not Indonesia.

Intelsat hereby informs the Commission that Intelsat currently is attempting to obtain from the government of Indonesia written confirmation of the statements made by Indosat in its May 9, 2005 letter. Should Intelsat obtain such a confirmation, we will provide a copy to the Commission so that it can be made part of the record in this proceeding.
