In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, EchoStar Satellite L.L.C. ("EchoStar") submits this letter to report that on June 10, 2005, the undersigned had a telephone conversation with Thomas Tycz, Chief Satellite Division of the International Bureau.
