Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat North America LLC ("Intelsat") hereby notifies the Commission that it has successfully de-orbited its Intelsat 605 satellite. The de-orbiting was completed on February 2, 2009. The final measured orbit of the Intelsat 605 satellite is 283.1 km above the geostationary arc, with an apogee and perigee of 291.6 km and 274.6 km above the arc, respectively. In the course of de-orbiting the satellite, Intelsat depleted the propellant tanks, discharged the batteries, disconnected the power from the bus, and shut off the transmitters.
