Dear Ms. Dortch:

New ICO Satellite Services G.P. ("ICO") hereby voluntarily surrenders the above-referenced modifications of its reservation of spectrum to add a second geostationary (GSO) satellite to its 2 GHz Mobile Satellite Service ("MSS") system at the 114.75° W.L. orbital location. Both modifications were granted by the Commission on December 18, 2006.¹ Due to the potential for difficulties in frequency coordination that have become apparent during the pendency of these applications, ICO will not pursue this aspect of its 2 GHz MSS system at this time.

We appreciate the diligent efforts of the Commission and its staff in addressing this matter.
