Dear Ms. Dortch:

PanAmSat Licensee Corp. ("PanAmSat") files this letter pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules,¹ to notify the Commission of the *pro forma* transfer of control of the applicant in the above referenced applications. Specifically, on October 30, 2006 Intelsat (Bermuda), Ltd. completed the series of transactions that resulted in Intelsat (Gibraltar) Limited, Intelsat (Luxembourg) S.a.r.l., and Intelsat (Poland) Sp. z o.o being interposed as 100 percent owned holding companies between Intelsat (Bermuda), Ltd., and Intelsat Holding Corporation. These transactions were fully described in several applications for authorization of *pro forma* transfer of control filed by Intelsat (Bermuda), Ltd. No comments were filed in opposition to these applications, which were granted by the Commission.²

Intelsat respectfully requests that this notification be included in the files for the above-referenced applications. The Commission has previously held, in its *First Space Station Reform Order*, that ownership changes arising from transfers of control would be classified as minor amendments.³ Accordingly, the instant amendment is minor, and the above referenced applications need not go back on public notice as a result of this amendment.


