**COMMENTS OF TERRESTAR NETWORKS INC.**

TerreStar Networks Inc. ("TerreStar") hereby supports the above-captioned request, filed by New ICO Satellite Services G.P. ("ICO"), seeking a six-week extension of the remaining milestones for launching ICO's 2 GHz mobile satellite service ("MSS") system and commencing operation of the system.<sup>1</sup> ICO's request is premised on an unexpected delay experienced by ICO's launch service provider. The circumstances outlined by ICO in its request are beyond ICO's control. Under well-established Commission precedent, therefore, and particularly in light of the facts that physical construction of ICO's
