

New ICO Satellite Services G.P.'s (New ICO's) applications, IBFS File Nos. SAT-MOD-20070806-00110¹ and SAT-AMD-20071109-00155,² to modify its 2 GHz Mobile Satellite Service (MSS) Spectrum Reservation (Spectrum Reservation) are GRANTED.³ Accordingly, New ICO's Spectrum Reservation is modified to reflect an extension of its milestones to launch its satellite, ICO G-1, at the 92.85° W.L. orbital location from November 30, 2007 to April 15, 2008 and its final milestone requiring it to certify that its entire system is operational from December 31, 2007 to May 15, 2008 subject to the following conditions:


