Pursuant to Section 25.280(a) of the Commission's rules (47 C.F.R. § 25.280(a)), PanAmSat Licensee Corp. hereby notifies the FCC of the commencement of inclined orbit operations for Intelsat 2, which currently is operating at 169.0° E.L. Set forth below is the information required by the Commission.

- (1) The operator's name is PanAmSat Licensee Corp.
- (2) The satellite is expected to leave the 0.05° inclination control box on January 3, 2008. The last north/south station-keeping maneuver occurred on December 10, 2008.
- (3) The initial inclination (after the last north/south station-keeping maneuver) was 0.025°.
- (4) The rate of change in inclination per year is as follows:

 $2008 - 0.936^{\circ}$ per year

 $2009 - 0.905^{\circ}$ per year

 $2010 - 0.872^{\circ}$ per year

 $2011 - 0.839^{\circ}$ per year

(5) The expected end-of-life of the satellite accounting for inclined orbit operations is June 2011.
