

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 8, 2010, L. Barbee Ponder IV, General Counsel of Globalstar Licensee LCC ("Globalstar"), James Monroe III, Executive Chairman of the Board of Directors of Globalstar, and Broderick D. Johnson of Bryan Cave LLP, met with Chairman Julius Genachowski, Edward P. Lazarus, Chief of Staff for Chairman Genachowski, and Zachary Katz, Legal Advisor to Chairman Genachowski, and Paul de Sa, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis. During their meeting, Msrs. Ponder, Monroe, and Johnson discussed the public interest reasons for granting Globalstar's pending request to modify the conditions under which the Commission has permitted Globalstar to offer broadband service as a part of its Mobile Satellite Ancillary Terrestrial Component authority. Msrs. Ponder, Monroe, and Johnson emphasized that such relief is critical to ensure the continued provision of broadband service to thousands of rural Americans. The views expressed on behalf of Globalstar were consistent with those expressed in its previous filings with the Commission.
