Iridium Constellation LLC ("Iridium") hereby notifies the Commission that, on June 19, 2016, it commenced maneuvering a satellite to plane 6, slot 4 and on June 23, 2016 turned on L-band service. In addition, Iridium notifies the Commission that it removed a satellite from its operational orbit in plane 6, slot 4 for the purpose of end-of-life disposal. As a result, the total number of operating satellites in Iridium's mission constellation is 65. The launch of the first ten Iridium NEXT satellites is scheduled for September 12, 2016.
