Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 12, 2014, DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC (“DIRECTV”) filed the above referenced application to modify its authorization for DIRECTV RB-2, a 17/24 GHz BSS payload on the DIRECTV 15 satellite, so that it will conform to the parameters of the DIRECTV 15 satellite that is currently awaiting launch. In that application, DIRECTV noted that the “details of the orbital debris mitigation plan for the satellite can be found in the application for DIRECTV 15, and is hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.”¹

Pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission’s rules, DIRECTV hereby notes that it recently submitted an amendment and request for limited waiver and a technical supplement thereto in connection with its pending DIRECTV 15 application, both of which relate to the satellite’s orbital debris mitigation plan.² Those materials should also be incorporated by reference into this proceeding.
