In this proceeding, DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC ("DIRECTV") has requested an extension of the license term for the DIRECTV 8 space station (call sign S2632). In response to a request from the International Bureau staff, DIRECTV hereby provides the following supplemental facts:

1. There have been no critical failures on the spacecraft that would result in lack of redundancy for any critical system, including propulsion and TT&C.
2. DIRECTV 8 has had some very minor, but acceptable, loss of solar panel capacity that is expected to have no impact on the spacecraft's ability to perform its mission.
3. There are no issues with any TT&C links, including backup TT&C.
