Dear Ms. Dortch:

On June 30, 2016, Terra Bella Technologies Inc. (Terra Bella) filed a "Notification of SkySat-3 Satellite Launch, In-Orbit Testing, and Operation" (Notification) updating the Commission on the status of its SkySat constellation and designating the undersigned as the technical contact for the constellation.¹ While not denominated as an annual report, that Notification contained information consistent with the reporting requirements under Section 25.170 of the Commission's rules.

For clarity and completeness, Terra Bella here summarizes the information required under Section 25.170 for its SkySat constellation:
