- 2. SES must operate AMC-16 at the 85° W.L. orbital location in accordance with any existing or future coordination agreements for this location.
- 3. SES is authorized to operate the AMC-16 satellite's Ka-band TT&C beacon with left-hand circular polarization in the frequency band 18.58385 GHz–18.58415 GHz.
- 4. SES is authorized to provide DTH services over the AMC-16 satellite, in both the Ka- and Ku-bands, in accordance with SES Americom, Inc., Applications for Modification of Fixed-Satellite Service Space Station License, *Order and Authorization*, 18 FCC Rcd 16589 (2003).
- 5. The operations of AMC-16 must comply with any agreement previously coordinated with United States
