SES must operate NSS-10 at the 37.45° W.L. orbital location in accordance with any existing or future coordination agreements for this location. 2. In connection with the provision of service in any particular country, SES is obliged to comply with the applicable laws, regulations, rules, and licensing procedures of that country. 3. The applicant's request for a waiver of Section 25.283(c) of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 25.283(c), is granted. Section 25.283(c) specifies that space stations must discharge all stored energy sources at end-of-life of the space station. NSS-10 is a Thales Alenia Space Spacebus-4000C3 model spacecraft that was launched on February 3, 2005. Applicant states that NSS-10's three helium tanks² were sealed immediately following the last orbit-raising maneuver during the launch phase for the satellite and cannot be further discharged. Applicant states that each of the sealed helium tanks will retain a total mass of approximately 485 grams of helium at end of life, with each tank volume being 51.6 liters. We grant a waiver of the Section 25.283(c) with respect to this de minimis amount of inert gas. 4. While at the 37.45° W.L. orbital location, Intelsat must maintain the NSS-10 spacecraft with an east/west longitudinal station-keeping tolerance of +/- 0.05 degrees. 5. The operations of NSS-10 and associated earth stations must comport with the applicable uplink and downlink limits in 47 CFR § 25.140(a)(3) of the Commission's rules, unless SES coordinates any non-

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conforming operations with the operations of U.S.-licensed geostationary orbit space stations within 6 degrees of the 37.45° W.L. orbital location. SES must also comport with the maximum power limits indicated in existing or future coordination agreements at 37.45° W.L. Non-conforming operation must also be coordinated with respect to those operations of non-U.S.-licensed space stations within 6 degrees of 37.45° W.L. involving approved communications with U.S.-licensed earth stations.

6. The license term for Call Sign S2415 is extended from April 6, 2020, through April 6, 2025.
7. Within 30 days of completion of the end-of-life maneuvers, SES shall send a letter to the Chief, Satellite Division, International Bureau, indicating the apogee and perigee of the NSS-10 disposal orbit.

Licensee/grantee is afforded thirty (30) days from the date of release of this action to decline the grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned.


