SpaceLink Corporation ("SpaceLink"), through its attorneys, hereby withdraws the above-referenced application filed on May 26, 2020, to modify the non-geostationary satellite orbit ("NGSO") fixed satellite service ("FSS") system authorized under Call Sign S2982.¹

SpaceLink remains firmly committed to launching and operating the world's first commercial satellite relay network. The instant letter does not propose additional modifications or changes to any technical parameters or spectrum frequencies previously authorized by the Commission pursuant to IBFS File No. SAT-LOA-20161115-00117 (granted) for SpaceLink's use in the aforementioned NGSO FSS relay system.
