³ T8 recently operated at the 100.75° W.L. orbital location under grant of special temporary authority. *See, e.g.*, IBFS File No. SAT-STA-20191120-00136. DIRECTV was then authorized under grant of special temporary authority to drift the T8 space station from the 100.75° W.L. orbital location to the 119.05° orbital location, beginning as early as September 1, 2020, and to operate from the 119.05° W.L. orbital location on a temporary basis. IBFS File No. SAT-STA-20200810-00095.

⁴ Although the T8 space station is capable of operating using Ka-band frequencies and was previously authorized to operate using the Ka-band in the fixed-satellite service, this grant does not authorize operations in the Ka-band at the 119.05° W.L. orbital location.

Unless otherwise specified herein, operations under this grant must comport with the legal and technical specifications set forth by the applicant or petitioner and with Federal Communication Commission's rules not waived herein. This grant is also subject to the following conditions:

- 1. DIRECTV must prepare the necessary information, as may be required, for submission to the International Telecommunication Union to initiate and complete the advance publication, international coordination, due diligence, and notification process of this space station, in accordance with the ITU Radio Regulations. DIRECTV shall be held responsible for all cost recovery fees associated with these ITU filings. We also note that no protection from interference caused by radio stations authorized by other administrations is guaranteed unless coordination and notification procedures are timely completed, or with respect to individual administrations, by successfully completing coordination agreements. Any radio station authorization for which coordination has not been completed may be subject to additional terms and conditions as required to effect coordination of the frequency assignments of other administrations. See 47 CFR § 25.111(b).
- 2. DIRECTV must maintain the T8 space station at the 119.05° W.L. orbital location with an east/west longitudinal station-keeping tolerance of \pm 0.05 degrees.
- 3. DIRECTV must operate T8 at the 119.05° W.L. orbital location in the frequencies specified above, subject to the conditions in prior grants.⁶
- 4. Within 30 days of completion of end-of-life maneuvers, DIRECTV must send a letter to the Chief, Satellite Division, International Bureau, indicating the apogee and perigee of the T8 space station disposal orbit.
- 5. Nothing in this authorization changes the license term for the T8 space station (Call Sign S2632), which expires on June 23, 2025 (*see* IBFS File No. SAT-MOD-20150304-00009).
- 6. DIRECTV must operate T8 in compliance with all existing or future coordination agreements for this location. In the absence of a coordination agreement, such communications must comply with applicable provisions of the ITU Radio Regulations as the Commission cannot guarantee the success of the required coordination.

Licensee/grantee is afforded thirty (30) days from the date of release of this action to decline the grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned.

This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.

Station licenses are subject to the conditions specified in Section 309(h) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 309(h).
