

Response to Question 34

Section 310(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, establishes certain limitations on foreign ownership and voting of certain common carrier and broadcast licensees. By definition, these limitations do not apply to the non-broadcast, non-common carrier operations of Viasat, Inc. In any event, the Commission recently issued an order consenting to the transfer of control of certain authorizations to Viasat, and this order and the associated filings identify the foreign entities known to hold Viasat stock, including their nationalities, their relationship to Viasat, and the percentage of stock voted.¹
