Eutelsat S.A. ("Eutelsat"), the petitioner in the above-referenced proceeding, hereby submits this letter pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, to withdraw certain aspects of its petition for declaratory ruling to modify the market access grant of the EUTELSAT 133WA satellite.<sup>1</sup>

Specifically, Eutelsat seeks to withdraw its request for authority to conduct emergency back-up TT&C operations with a U.S. earth station in S-band frequencies on a nonconforming basis, as well as an associated waiver request. Eutelsat respectfully requests that the petition be processed only with respect to the remaining proposed modifications of its market access grant.
