Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with Section 25.165 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.165, and paragraph 25.a of the Order and Declaratory Ruling¹ granting access to the U.S. Market to LeoSat MA, Inc. ("LeoSat") for the operation of a non-geostationary satellite system operating in Ka-band spectrum, LeoSat hereby submits the attached surety bond rider.

The surety bond rider is in the dollar amount of \$60,000 (increasing the bond amount to \$1,340,000) which is the amount required to cover the 31-day period from April 20, 2019 until May 20, 2019 pursuant to the formula set forth in Section 25.165(a)(1) of the Commission's rules.² LeoSat and the surety will execute a rider to the bond on or before May 20, 2019 to increase the amount of the bond in accordance with the Commission's requirements. Following the close of LeoSat's Series A financing, which LeoSat expects to occur shortly, LeoSat expects to file future riders covering periods of time of one year or longer.

Power of Attorney

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that ATLANTIC SPECIALTY INSURANCE COMPANY, a New York corporation with its principal office in Plymouth, Minnesota, does hereby constitute and appoint: **Cori Riddle**, each individually if there be more than one named, its true and lawful Attorney-in-Fact, to make, execute, seal and deliver, for and on its behalf as surety, any and all bonds, recognizances, contracts of indemnity, and all other writings obligatory in the nature thereof; provided that no bond or undertaking executed under this authority shall exceed in amount the sum of: **sixty million dollars (\$60,000,000)** and the execution of such bonds, recognizances, contracts of indemnity, and all other writings obligatory in the nature thereof in pursuance of these presents, shall be as binding upon said Company as if they had been fully signed by an authorized officer of the Company and sealed with the Company seal.
