Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with Section 25.165 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.165, and paragraph 25.a of the Order and Declaratory Ruling¹ granting access to the U.S. market to LeoSat MA, Inc. ("LeoSat") for the operation of a non-geostationary satellite system operating in Ka-band spectrum, LeoSat hereby submits the attached surety bond rider.

The surety bond rider increases the overall bond amount by \$20,000 to \$1,510,000 which is the amount required to cover the period through and including August 25, 2019 pursuant to the formula set forth in Section 25.165(a)(1) of the Commission's rules.² LeoSat and the surety will execute a further rider to the bond on or before August 25, 2019 to increase the amount of the bond in accordance with the Commission's requirements.




