On June 20, 2019, the undersigned and Henry Goldberg, counsel to Telesat Canada ("Telesat"), had a phone conversation with Karl Kensinger of the FCC's International Bureau. They spoke concerning filings submitted by Space Exploration Holdings, LLC ("SpaceX") on June 12 and 13, 2019. In those filings, SpaceX claimed its NGSO FSS system is entitled to first choice of "home base" Ku-band frequencies because to date only its system is communicating with a U.S.-licensed earth station in the band. They informed Mr. Kensinger they believe SpaceX has misread the Commission's rules.
