Dear Mr. Albuquerque:

By this letter, Spire Global, Inc. ("Spire") amends the pending market access application to request authority for no more than 636 MINAS Luxembourg-authorized satellites. At the same time, Spire is also requesting the International Bureau concurrently modify (or further condition) Spire's Phase II license grant to authorize the launch of no more than 236 LEMUR-2 (Phase II) United States-authorized satellites, instead of the currently authorized total of 872 satellites.¹
