Description of Transaction

Inmarsat Group Holdings Limited, formerly known as Inmarsat plc (“Inmarsat”), pursuant to the *Satellite Licensing Streamlining Order* and Section 25.137(g) of the Commission’s rules,¹ hereby notifies the Commission of a change in ownership.² Specifically, on December 4, 2019, Connect Bidco Limited, a Guernsey corporation (“Connect Bidco”) acquired control of Inmarsat (the “Transaction”).³ As part of the Transaction, Connect Bidco acquired indirect control of Inmarsat Inc., Inmarsat Solutions (US) Inc. (“ISUS”), and ISAT US Inc. (“ISAT”) (each a “Licensee” and together the “Inmarsat Licensees”), which hold Part 25 space station market access rights, as set out below.⁴ The Inmarsat Licensees remain indirect, wholly-owned subsidiaries of Inmarsat.

I. Officers, Directors, and Ten Percent or Greater Shareholders – Responsive to Question 40

Connect Bidco is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Connect Midco Limited (“Connect Midco”), a Guernsey limited company, which in turn is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Connect Sub-Topco Limited (“Connect Sub-Topco”), a Guernsey limited company. Connect Sub-Topco is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Connect Topco Limited (“Connect Topco”), a Guernsey limited

The change of control occurred on December 4, 2019 when the scheme of arrangement was sanctioned by the court and filed with the UK commercial register, and the parties completed the Transaction on December 18, 2019 when the prior shareholders of Inmarsat received their final consideration.

company. Connect Topco is the owned by the following entities, each of which holds 25 percent of Connect Topco’s voting shares:

Triton LuxtopHolding SARL, a Luxembourg limited liability company, is controlled by Apax IX GP Co. Limited, which holds legal ownership of the voting interest of Triton LuxTop for the benefit of certain limited partnerships, for which it also serves as Investment Manager.⁵ Additional information regarding the Apax entities is set out below.

WP Triton Co-Invest, L.P., a Cayman Islands exempted limited partnership, is owned by several investment funds advised by Warburg Pincus LLC or its affiliates. Additional information regarding the Warburg Pincus entities is set out below.

CPP Investment Board Private Holdings (4) Inc., a Canadian corporation, is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Canada Pension Plan Investment Board. CPPIB is the investment management organization that invests the funds not needed by the Canada Pension Plan to pay current benefits in the best interests of 20 million contributors and beneficiaries.

⁵ In the applications seeking consent to the Transaction, it had been contemplated that the four Apax IX limited partnerships (Apax IX USD, L.P., Apax IX USD Co-Investment L.P., Apax IX EUR L.P., and Apax IX EUR Co-Investment L.P.) would hold the legal interest in Triton LuxTop directly. For various administrative and other reasons, however, at closing, the legal ownership of the shares was acquired by Apax IX GP Co. Limited, and the four Apax limited partnerships described in the applications are the beneficial owners of the shares. As noted in the applications, however, only one of the Apax limited partnerships—Apax IX USD, L.P.—has an indirect interest in Inmarsat and the Inmarsat Licensees of 10 percent or more. In addition, as contemplated in the applications, a fifth limited partnership acquired an insulated interest in Triton LuxTop, representing an indirect interest in Inmarsat and Licensees of less than 5 percent, and holds its shares directly in Triton LuxTop.

II. Notification of Transfer of Control of Permitted Space Station List Satellites – Responsive to Question 42a

Additionally, Part 25 market access authorization for the Inmarsat-3 F2 and F3 satellites was obtained through an earth station application filed by an entity not affiliated with Inmarsat, specifically an application for E000284 initially licensed to Vizada (*see* IBFS File Nos. SES-LIC-20070416-00479 and SES-AMD-20070920-01300). The license for E000284 is now held by Comsat, Inc. Because Inmarsat does not control the earth station licensee, the notification of the consummation of the transaction is being filed as a pleading in the IBFS file for E000284 (IBFS File No. SES-MOD-20151009-00700).

In light of this change in control, Inmarsat requests that the Commission issue a public notice announcing the Transaction and inviting comment on whether the Transaction will affect any of the considerations made when Inmarsat was allowed to enter the U.S. market. Consistent with the Commission's rules, Inmarsat will continue to operate its market access satellites in accordance with the conditions of the respective orders unless otherwise notified by the Commission.¹³ As the Commission has noted, the ability of non-U.S.-licensed satellite operators to offer service to U.S. customers advances the public interest by enhancing competition in the U.S. market.¹⁴ The operation of Inmarsat satellites will continue to serve this important public interest by driving competition and improving services for U.S. based customers.
