Conditions of Permitted Space Station List Grant
February 15, 2006

Pursuant to Sections 303(r), 308, 309, and 310 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 303(r), 308, 309, 310, and Sections 0.261 and 25.137(c) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.261, 25.137(c), the Petition for Declaratory Ruling filed by Space Communication Corporation (File No. SAT-PPL-20051101-00208) to add its in-orbit Superbird-B2 satellite at 162° E.L. to the Permitted Space Station List is GRANTED. Accordingly, each U.S.-licensed earth station with "ALSAT" designated as a point of communication IS GRANTED authority to provide Fixed Satellite Services (FSS) in the 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands, from the United States, by accessing the Superbird-B2 satellite at the 162° E.L. orbit location, in accordance with the technical specifications set forth in its petition for declaratory ruling, this Attachment, and the Commission's Rules and subject to the following conditions:

1. ALSAT-designated earth stations are permitted to communicate with the SUPERBIRD-B2 satellite in the 14.0-14.5 GHz (Earth-to-space) frequencies consistent with the technical parameters contained in the earth station authorization. Communications in any other band are not permitted.
2. Grant of Petition for Declaratory Ruling filed by Space Communication Corporation to add its in-orbit Superbird-B2 satellite at 162° E.L. to the Permitted Space Station List does not include any downlink frequencies. Accordingly, ALSAT-designated earth stations may not receive transmissions from the SUPERBIRD-B2 satellite unless expressly authorized in the earth station(s) respective license.
3. Communications between ALSAT-designated earth stations and the SUPERBIRD-B2 satellite shall be in compliance with satellite coordination agreements reached between the United States and Japan.
4. SUPERBIRD-B2 is not authorized to provide any Direct-to-Home (DTH) service, Direct Broadcast Satellite (DBS) service, or Digital Audio Radio Service (DARS) to, from, or within the United States.
5. This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective immediately.
