


Dear Mr. Nelson,

As you are aware Satelites Mexicanos, S.A. de C.V. ("SATMEX") on March 29, 2006 filed an application with the Commission to add the Satmex 6 satellite at 113°W to the Permitted Space Station List. Although the Commission has not yet taken any action on this application SATMEX would like to inform the Commission that the Satmex 6 satellite was successfully launched on May 27, 2006 by Arianespace.

The satellite will be at the 113°W orbital location and fully operational on July 4, 2006. As described in the application SATMEX would like to begin provision of service to the U.S. in early July. We hope this information will prompt the Commission to place the Satmex 6 application on Public Notice. Please let us know if there is anything we can do to expedite the processing of our application.
