Dear Ms. Dortch:

On November 20, 2013, Satélites Mexicanos, S.A. de C.V. notified the Commission, pursuant to Section 25.137(g) of the Commission's rules, of a planned transfer of control from Satélites Mexicanos to Eutelsat S.A. The Notification of planned transfer was placed on Public notice on November 22, 2013. (See Public Notice, Report No. SAT-00981). The Commission did not receive any comments.

After review, the Satellite Division determined that the planned transfer of control of Satélites Mexicanos would not affect any of the considerations made when the Mexican-licensed Satmex 5 (S2589), Satmex 6 (S2695), and Satmex 8 (S2873) satellites were initially granted U.S. market access.

In accordance with the grant by the Commission, SatMex hereby informs the Commission that on January 1, 2014 the transactions reflected in the underlying application were consummated and requests that the Permitted Space Station List be updated accordingly.
