
The petition of Inmarsat plc (Inmarsat), IBFS File No. SAT-PPL-20141003-00106, pursuant to Section 25.137 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.137, to modify the "ISAT List" to include the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite at the 98° W.L. orbital location IS GRANTED. Accordingly, any U.S.-licensed earth station with ISAT listed as a point of communication is permitted to access the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite at the 98° W.L. orbital location in the 1525-1559 MHz (space-to-Earth) and 1626.5-1660.5 MHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands without additional authorization from the Commission, provided that the earth station complies with the Commission's technical requirements and operates under the conditions on its license. The grant of this petition is subject to the specifications set forth in Inmarsat's petition, the Commission's rules, and the following conditions:

- 1. Authority IS GRANTED, pursuant to Section 25.210(j) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.210(j), to permit operations of earth stations with the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite maintained at ± 0.10 degree of the 98° W.L. orbital location, subject to the condition that this waiver shall terminate in the event that a satellite is launched into a location such that its stationkeeping volume would overlap the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite's ± 0.10 degree stationkeeping volume, but would not overlap the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite's ± 0.05 degree stationkeeping volume, unless Inmarsat has successfully coordinated its physical operations with those of the other spacecraft.
- 2. Operations via the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite using a north-south inclination of as much as three degrees ARE GRANTED, conditioned on operations of the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite complying with the inclined orbit requirements set forth in Sections 25.280(b)(1)-(3) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.280(b)(1)-(3).
- 3. Licensees must comply with the terms of any L-band operator-to-operator coordination agreement. In the absence of a continuing L-band operator-to-operator coordination agreement, operations of mobile earth stations in the 1525-1559 MHz and 1626.5-1660.5 MHz bands will be on a non-harmful interference basis until a future operator-to-operator agreement is concluded. In this event, each licensee must notify the other operators in these frequency bands that it will be operating on a non-harmful interference basis. Each licensee must notify its customers that its operations are on a non-harmful interference basis.
- 4. This grant is subject to compliance with the provisions of the Agreement between Inmarsat on the one hand and the U.S. Department of Justice and the Department of Homeland Security on the other, dated September 23, 2008. A copy of the Agreement is publicly available in DA 09-117, Appendix B.

¹ The Inmarsat 4F3 satellite was previously placed on the ISAT List at the 97.65° W.L. orbital location. Inmarsat, Inc., IBFS File No. SES-PDR-20080303-00367 (granting request to add the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite to the ISAT List, Dec. 17, 2008); see also Inmarsat Hawaii Inc., IBFS File Nos. SES-MFS-20080228-00207, SES-AFS-20080410-00448, and SES-AFS-20080915-01200 (granting U.S. market access via the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite in additional frequency bands, Dec. 18, 2008). A technical description of the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite may be found in IBFS File No. SES-MFS-20080228-00207, Exhibit D.

- 5. This grant of market access will terminate in the event that the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite is relocated from the 98° W.L. orbital location or ceases to operate. In either case, the Inmarsat 4F3 satellite will be removed from the ISAT List. If Inmarsat wishes to provide service to the United States using another satellite, it must file a new application to have that satellite placed on the ISAT List.
- 6. Inmarsat is afforded 30 days from the date of the release of this action to decline this grant as conditioned. Failure to respond within this period will constitute formal acceptance of the grant as conditioned.
- 7. This action is taken pursuant to the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective immediately. Petitions for reconsideration under Section 1.106, or applications for review under Section 1.115 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 1.106, 1.115, may be filed within 30 days of the date of the public notice indicating that this action was taken.

PETITION FOR DECLARATORY RULING

Pursuant to Section 25.137(d) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.137(d) and the Commission's order establishing the ISAT List, ¹ Inmarsat plc ("Inmarsat") seeks to modify the ISAT List to specify the location of the Inmarsat-4 F3 satellite ("I4F3") to be 98.0° W.L. I4F3 currently is identified in the ISAT List as being located at the nominal 98° W.L. location, with an offset to 97.65° W.L. to avoid overlapping the station-keeping volume of the Inmarsat-2 F2 spacecraft that was previously located at 98.0° W.L. ²

I4F3 originally was placed on the ISAT List to reflect the grant of authority for earth stations KA25 and E080059 to communicate with that spacecraft. Inmarsat currently has applications pending to modify the authorizations for those earth stations to reflect the operation of I4F3 at 98° W.L. with no station-keeping offset, as well as related requests for STA. Inmarsat respectfully requests that the ISAT List maintained by the Commission with respect to Inmarsat's L band satellite operations (1525-1559 MHz, 1626.5-1660.5 MHz) be updated upon the grant of those earth station applications. Grant of this Petition for Declaratory Ruling would

Inmarsat Hawaii Inc. FCC Form 312 Exhibit B Response to Question 36

Inmarsat Hawaii Inc. submits this response to Question 36 of FCC Form 312 out of an abundance of caution. In 2005, the Commission dismissed a Petition for Declaratory Ruling (the "Petition") filed by Inmarsat Hawaii Inc.'s affiliate, Inmarsat Global Limited ("Inmarsat Global"), seeking United States market access to provide MSS in the 2 GHz band. Subsequent to Inmarsat Global's filing, the Commission assigned all 2 GHz spectrum currently allocated for MSS in the United States to two other satellite operators, and thus dismissed Inmarsat Global's Petition.¹
