The International Telecommunications Satellite Organization (INTELSAT), by its attorneys and pursuant to Section 1.106 of the Commission's Rules, hereby requests the Chief of the International Bureau to reconsider its Order and Authorization, released July 5, 1996 (DA 96-1080), which extended the Special Temporary Authority (STA) previously granted to Columbia Communications Corporation for a period of 180 days.¹ In support whereof, the following is shown:
