Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat") hereby notifies the Commission that it has successfully de-orbited its Intelsat 7 satellite. De-orbit was completed on February 26, 2016. The final measured orbit of the Intelsat 7 satellite is 588 km above the geostationary arc, with an apogee and perigee of 599 km and 577 km above the arc, respectively. In the course of de-orbiting the satellite, Intelsat depleted the propellant tanks, discharged the batteries, disconnected the power from the bus, and shut off the transmitters.
