## MOTION TO DESIGNATE PROCEEDING AS "PERMIT-BUT-DISCLOSE"

Pegasus Development Corporation ("Pegasus") hereby requests that the Commission designate the ex parte status of the above-captioned application of DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC ("DIRECTV") as "permit-but-disclose." Pursuant to the Commission's rules, "[w]here the public interest so requires in a particular proceeding, the Commission and its staff retain the discretion to modify the applicable ex parte rules by order, letter, or public notice." 47 C.F.R. § 1.1200(a).

DIRECTV proposes to move DIRECTV 5 from 119°W to 72.5°W, which is an orbital location assigned to Canada, and subsequently to provide Direct Broadcast Satellite ("DBS") service to the United States from that location.<sup>1</sup> The Commission previously has designated applications proposing to provide DBS services to the United States from Canada as "permit-butdisclose" because of the "intricate legal and technical issues" associated with such proposals.<sup>2</sup>

Moreover, the application is relevant to the proceeding for authority to transfer control of FCC authorizations from General Motors Corporation, Hughes Electronics Corporation to The News Corporation Limited. *See* In the Matter of General Motors et al., FCC 03-330 (January 14, 2004). That proceeding has also been designated "permit-but-disclose." *See* Public Notice, DA 03-1725 (May 16, 2003).

Based on the foregoing, Pegasus respectfully requests that the Commission designate the *ex parte* status of the above-captioned application as "permit-but-disclose."
