- 4. While drifting the DIRECTV 8 satellite to and between 102.8° W.L., 99.2° W.L., and 101° W.L., orbital locations, DIRECTV is required to accept interference from other lawfully operating in-orbit satellites.
- 5. Operation of DIRECTV 8's Ka-band payload at the 9.2° W.L. and 102.8° W.L. orbital locations is limited to the "proof of concept video transmissions" described by DIRECTV in its application and may not be used for commercial services.
- 6. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special authority is solely at DIRECTV's own risk.
- DIRECTV shall notify the Commission in writing no later than three business days after DIRECTV 8 has arrived at 102.8° W.L., 99.2° W.L., and 101° W.L. orbital locations.
- 8. This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.

DIRECTV Enterprises, L.L.C.'s (DIRECTV) requests for special temporary authority (STA) filed on May 6, 2005, IBFS File No. SAT-STA-20050506-00095¹ and SAT-STA-20050506-00096, ARE GRANTED. Accordingly, DIRECTV is authorized on a non-interference basis² (1) to operate Tracking, Telemetry, and Command ("TT&C") functions in the 17307 MHz (Earth-to-Space) and 12203.25 and 12203.75 MHz (Space-to-Earth) frequencies at and during transit between the 102.8° W.L., 99.2° W.L., and 101° W.L. orbital locations and (2) to operate the Ka-band communications payload on the DIRECTV 8 satellite at the 102.8° W.L. orbital location for up to four days ending on June 3, 2005, and thereafter to drift to the 99.2° W.L. orbital location and operate the Ka-band communications payload for a period of up to 18 days ending June 23, 2005 in accordance with the terms, conditions, and technical specifications set forth in its application, the Commission's rules and this Attachment; and

- During the drift of the satellite to and between the 102.8° W.L., 99.2° W.L., and 101° W.L. orbital locations, DIRECTV shall not operate the Direct Broadcast Satellite ("DBS") or Ka-band communications payload on the DIRECTV 8 satellite.
- DIRECTV shall coordinate all of its TT&C operations with existing geostationary satellites to ensure that no unacceptable interference results from its TT&C operations during its drift.
- 3. During the drift of the satellite to and between 102.8° W.L., 99.2° W.L., and 101° W.L. orbital locations, no harmful interference shall be caused by the DIRECTV 8 satellite to any other lawfully operating satellites or radiocommunication systems.
  Operations of the DIRECTV 8 satellite shall cease immediately upon notification of such
