
Dear Mr. Nelson:

On January 20, 2006, the Commission granted the above referenced request for authority to relocate the DIRECTV 2 satellite to the nominal 91° W.L. orbital location allocated to Canada under the ITU's Region 2 BSS Plan. Pursuant to Condition 7 of that authorization, DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC ("DIRECTV") hereby notifies the Commission that the satellite has completed the migration to its new orbital location.

In addition, further to my letter of February 2, 2006, this is to inform you that Telesat Canada has finalized a Technical Assistance Agreement with the U.S. Department of State, clearing the last contingency for use of Telesat's earth stations to provide telemetry, tracking, and control communications to the satellite commencing on March 6, 2006.
