("Sirius"), by its counsel, notifies the Commission that on February 6, 2007, Patrick Donnelly, Executive Vice President and General Counsel of Sirius, and Robert Pettit, Carl Frank, and Jennifer Hindin of Wiley Rein LLP met with Roderick Porter, Robert Nelson, Richard Engelman, Karl Kensinger and Gardner Foster of the FCC, International Bureau.
