SUPPLEMENT TO MT. WILSON REPLY TO OPPOSITION TO PETITION TO DENY

Mt. Wilson FM Broadcasters, Inc. ("Mt. Wilson") filed a Petition to Deny the above-referenced application of Sirius Satellite Radio, Inc. ("Sirius"). Sirius filed an Opposition to the Mt. Wilson Petition on January 18, 2007 and Mt. Wilson filed a "Reply" on January 30, 2007.

The Sirius application proposed terrestrial repeaters in Alaska and Hawaii. The Sirius Opposition asserts that Mt. Wilson is not a "party-in-interest." Inadvertently, the Mt. Wilson Petition and the Mt. Wilson Reply failed to state that Mt. Wilson is the licensee of FM translator station K288CS, Kawaihae, Hawaii and which carries the signal

of station KRTR-FM, Kailua, Hawaii. Consequently, Mt. Wilson believes that it is a
“party-in-interest.”¹
