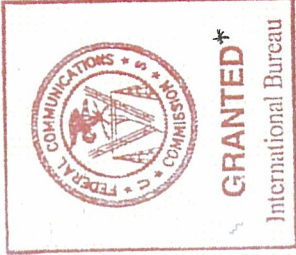

The request by Globalstar Licensee LLC for Special Temporary Authority for 180 days to operate a 48-satellite constellation consisting of an eight-plane, 16-satellite and 32-satellite Walker array, with up to 7 satellites per plane, and with the satellite phasing and other orbital parameters specified in the request filed on July 13, 2007, and as further described in Globalstar Licensee LLC's letter dated December 14, 2009, IS GRANTED, subject to the following conditions:

1. Globalstar Licensee LLC shall reserve sufficient propellant aboard satellites launched after May 25, 2007 to move those satellites to an end-of-mission disposal orbit with a perigee altitude above 2000 kilometers.
2. Globalstar Licensee LLC may make further adjustments in satellite phasing to optimize quality of service.
3. The period of this authorization shall commence on the grant date specified above.
4. This action is without prejudice to any enforcement action concerning operations prior to the grant date.
5. This grant is issued on delegated authority pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release. Petitions for reconsideration under Section 1.106 or applications for review under Section 1.115 of the rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.106 and 1.115, may be filed within 30 days of the date of the public notice announcing this action.
