- (1) The operator's name is PanAmSat Licensee Corp.
- (2) The last north/south station-keeping maneuver occurred on August 23, 2008.
- (3) The initial inclination (after the last north/south station-keeping maneuver) was 0.0283°.
- (4) The rate of change in inclination per year is as follows:
  2008 0.936° per year
  2009 0.905° per year
- (5) The expected end-of-life of the satellite accounting for inclined orbit operation is July 2010.
