
Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 14, 2007, XM Radio Inc. ("XM") filed the above-referenced request for a 30-day Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for a new very low power repeater to be located at an office building at 2650 Park Tower Drive, Vienna, VA, to which XM is relocating some employees.

XM herein amends that request to change it from one seeking a 30-Day STA to one seeking a 60-day STA. See 47 C.F.R. § 25.120(b)(3). Today, XM has also filed a request for a 180-day STA seeking to authorize long term operations at the same site.
