Conditions for Grant of Disaster related Extension STA request

Date: February, 2010

- Iridium LLC's (Iridium) February 3, 2010 request extension for special temporary authority (STA) IS GRANTED. Accordingly, Iridium is authorized from February 5, 2010 to February 15, 2010 to test and then to operate its Mobile Satellite Service (MSS) in the 1.775 MHz of spectrum from 1616-1617.775 MHz in accordance with the terms, conditions, and technical specifications set forth in the Commission's rules and this document.
1. The Iridium satellite system shall operate on a co-equal status with the Globalstar satellite system in the 1616-1618.725 MHz band within Region 2. In areas outside of Region 2, the Iridium satellite system must operate in the 1616-1618.725 MHz frequency band on a non-harmful interference basis with respect to any other allocated radio service in that band, i.e., Iridium shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating satellites. In the event Iridium is notified of such interference, it must immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
 2. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special authority is solely at Iridium's own risk.
 3. Iridium shall maintain the capability of suspending operations in the 1616-1617.775 MHz band, upon notice from the Commission, within 24 hours.
 4. This STA may be terminated at the International Bureau's discretion, without a hearing, if conditions warrant. Under no circumstances may the facility(ies) authorized violate the terms of an international agreement or treaty. If an application for permanent authority is on file with the Commission, this action is taken without prejudice to that application. The applicant is required to post and/or retain a copy of this authorization as required by the Commission's Rules.
 5. This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective immediately.
