Iridium Satellite LLC ("Iridium"), by its attorneys, hereby surrenders its special temporary authority ("STA") to operate in the $1616-1617.775 \mathrm{MHz}$ band. Iridium has been monitoring usage of its global satellite system since it first obtained STA to use additional spectrum following the March 11, 2011 earthquake and tsunami in Japan. Iridium's recent data shows that in the last few days the traffic over Japan has stabilized with an overall approximate $50 \%$ increase in subscribers as compared to pre-earthquake levels. As a result, Iridium will cease using the 1616.0-1617.775 MHz band effective April 2, 2011. ${ }^{1}$ As noted in Iridium's last extension request, however, approximately 2700 additional phones are en route to the Japan region for use by non-governmental relief organizations. Iridium may seek additional STA as needed to accommodate any increased demand following the activation of these phones.
