Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat"), pursuant to condition #4 of the June 15, 2011 grant of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") authorizing Intelsat to de-orbit the Intelsat 3R satellite (Call Sign PAS-2R) from its current location at 81.0° W.L. and to perform telemetry, tracking and command ("TT&C") functions with Intelsat 3R during this maneuver,¹ hereby informs the Commission of the following.

The actual expected date of commencement of end-of-life maneuvers for the Intelsat 3R satellite is July 6, 2011. On that date, Intelsat will start the first de-orbit burn.
