Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat") hereby notifies the Commission that it has successfully de-orbited its Intelsat 706 satellite. The de-orbiting was completed on December 8, 2014. The final measured orbit of the Intelsat 706 satellite is 348.5 km above the geostationary arc, with an apogee and perigee of 363.6 km and 333.5 km above the arc, respectively. In the course of de-orbiting the satellite, Intelsat depleted the propellant tanks, discharged the batteries, disconnected the power from the bus, and shut off the transmitters.
